



Requirements

Dog Registration

WALA Member Breeders must identify all active WALA breeding dogs on their website, including displaying the dog's WALA number and full, official name, including breeder prefix.

WALA will require that each dog being registered have both parents already registered in the WALA registry, or submit a six-generation pedigree, or one that can be traced to six generations, for authentication, along with appropriate fee.

The dog must be fully traceable in the pedigrees to one of the WALA accepted Clubs and Associations.

- Registered names and numbers must be provided for as many of the dogs in the pedigree as possible.
- Each dog in the pedigree will be registered in the WALA Registry according to the WALA Grading Scheme.

Any breeder, WALA or non-WALA, may submit a pedigree for verification to the WALA Registration Team for a fee. The pedigree should contain as many generations and official names and numbers as possible. Email:
